

A Day Just for Drawing with Mary Ann McArdle

The first guideline is not to stress about supplies, purchase whatever your budget will allow! This is a class about relaxing and finding joy in the creative process.

Drawing paper pad at least 12 x 18 inches, like the Blick Studio Drawing Pad .

Newsprint pad or scrap computer paper for practice drawings

HB and 2B pencil (hard and soft)

Eraser (kneaded erasers work best)

Hand sharpener

Conte crayons and/or willow or vine charcoal (hard and/or soft).

You don't need all of them but a few to compare to pencil.

(optional) Colored pencils or colored conte crayons if you wish to work with color.

Paper towels or rags

Masking Tape
