

## Water Color Supplies List

### Paper

I recommend Winsor & Newton's Cotman Watercolor Pads. They contain 12 sheets of fine quality watercolor paper, spiral bound on the short side. The 140 lb, cold-press paper is sturdy and non-buckling.

### Paints

Water color paints - I recommend Winsor Newton Watercolor paints.

- Cadmium Yellow
- Cadmium Red
- Viridian Green
- Cobalt Blue
- Prussian Blue
- Alizarin Crimson

A paint tube or pan set will also do instead of buying individual colors



### Brushes

Brushes should soft springy very well set in the ferrule and hold a lot of water which makes them ideal for washes and always make a good point. Recommended sizes

- #3 Round
- #6 Round
- #10 - could be ox hair or synthetic as a sable hair would be expensive

## Palette

it must be white and have recesses for mixing colors. A white tile or a white plate can be used too.

## Other Equipment

- Sponges
- Cotton rags
- Erasers
- Pencils
- Water containers (at least two or three good size containers)

Like anything else, the better quality paints and brushes may cost more, but are better quality and last longer. I recommend any size of **Winsor and Newton** paint. But buy what you can afford.
